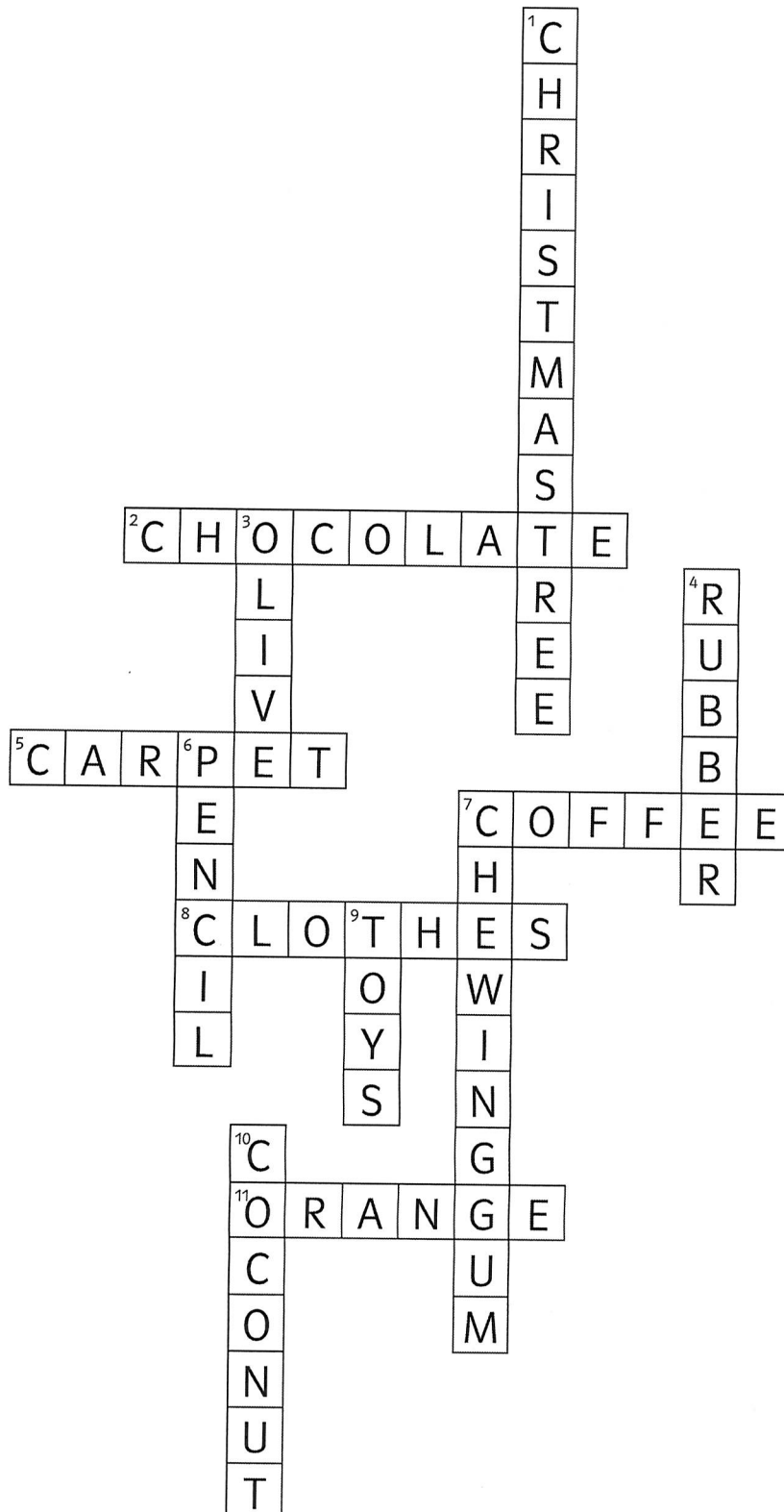

The woodpecker has a very strong beak. With its beak the woodpecker pecks holes into the trees to find food. The insects lives under the bark of the tree.

The woodpecker has very strong feet for climbing. It has four toes, two in front and two at the back. Its tail is also very strong. The parrot has good feet for climbing too.

The woodpecker's tongue looks like a worm. It is very strong. There are some short hairs. They help the woodpecker catch insects.

The woodpecker pecks a very big hole into the tree to make a nest. It lays two to eight eggs.
